Please go to your signposted warm-up area next to the running track between 1:15pm & 1:25pm, to be ready for the start at 1:30pm.

CATEGORY 2: BOYS

Please go to your signposted warm-up area next to the running track between 1:30pm & 1:40pm, to be ready for the start at 1:45pm.

CATEGORY 3: GIRLS

Please go to your signposted warm-up area next to the running track between 1:45pm & 1:55pm, to be ready for the start at 2:00pm.

CATEGORY 3: BOYS

Please go to your signposted warm-up area next to the running track between

All races will start and finish on the running track in the playing fields behind the Garioch Sports Centre, under the gantry. The running track itself is located to the east of the enclosed astroturf football pitches, between the astroturf and Strathburn School.

Runners should make their way to the waiting area next to the running track at the times indicated for their categories. There will be event marshals and signage in the area to direct you. Please also feel free to ask the marshals or the volunteers at Junior Run HQ for assistance or information at any time.

Parents/guardians are NOT permitted within the waiting area, but there will be a designated area for spectators next to the start/finish line. There will also be good views of the last section of the CAT2 and CAT3 courses from Strathburn Park.


From the waiting area, each category of runners will be taken for a warm-up, and then to the start line, by members of the Junior Run Team. Please note that the boys and girls of each age category will again be running separately this year.

When the runners have finished their races, they will be directed to the finish zone, where they will await collection.






Coroup Event Village

GETTING TO RUN GARIOCH

If you're driving to the event we would encourage you NOT to enter Inverurie from the roundabout on the A96 near Morrisons. Burghmuir Drive (the start & finish of the adult races) will be closed all day from the Strathburn Hotel up to the roundabout at Morrisons.

Burghmuir Circle will only be open for local access and VIP Parking (but only via the Strathburn Hotel junction).

To ease congestion around Morrisons and Blackhall Road, we've introduced a 'Drop-off' Zone at Strathburn School, which is located at the back of the Garioch Sports Centre (sat-nav post code AB51 4RY) and is only a short walk from the start lines.

In addition to the 400 places available at the Aberdeenshire Council offices at Gordon House (Blackhall Road - AB51 3WA), we've also secured agreement from several local businesses to use their car parks on race day. Please see the website for further details. Many thanks to them all for their support. There are also other public car parks located elsewhere in town.

Toilets will be located in the lower car park. There will be no access to the toilets in the Reception and Gym areas of the GSC for runners or spectators.


